

If you are new to the wonderful world of chalk art, here are some things to consider:

1. **Wear comfortable clothing** — you will get dirty! Remember, you will be sitting on the ground bent over while drawing...crack kills! ☺
2. **Hat and/or sunscreen.** Some areas in the park are shady, some are not.
3. **Something to sit on or put your knees on.** The concrete gets very uncomfortable (garden kneepads work well or cushions).
4. **A piece of cardboard is good to have** in case you need to sit on a finished area of your piece because it won't smear it.
5. **Thin, but durable, snug fitting rubber gloves** to protect your hands.
6. **Plenty of water.**
7. **Baby wipes are nice to have** to clean your hands and areas on your artwork.
8. **Blending tools** like Q-tips, makeup sponges, paint brushes, spray bottles, cloth rags, and small carpet squares are also things you might consider bringing.
9. **Your business cards** or other samples of your work to show visitors (small portfolio).
10. **Some extra cash** to spend on food and amazing arts and crafts.
